Pastor's Thoughts

February: A Month to Walk in Faith and Love

As we enter February, a month often associated with love, let us be reminded of the greatest love of all—the love of Jesus Christ. His love is unconditional, unwavering, and eternal. In this season, may we draw closer to Him, embracing His grace and reflecting His love to those around us.

1 John 4:9-10 tells us:

"This is how God showed His love among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins."

God's love is not based on what we do, but on who He is. No matter where we've been or what we've faced, His love remains constant. This February, take time to rest in His presence and remember that His love is more than enough to sustain you through any trial.
